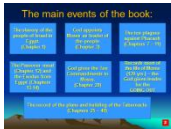

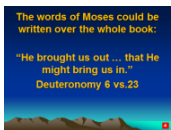

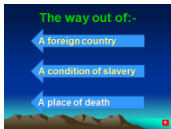
 – The Main Events of the Book. ‡ The events of the book cover about 430 years – Exodus 12: 40-41 – the margin note shows that this period includes the years in the land of Canaan from Abraham to Jacob (Galatians 3: 17). The book starts with 70 people – the family of Israel (Ex. 1: 5). In the 2nd year after the children of Israel left Egypt, (Numbers 1: 1), a census was taken of the Children of Israel. They numbered 603,550 men of 20 yrs. +, excluding the Levites (Numbers 1: 46). ‡ to open →

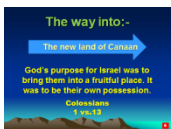
 – The words of Moses could be written over the whole book. † “He brought us out ... that He might bring us in”. Deuteronomy 6: 23. † to open →

 – **The Way Out of** - ‡ a foreign land (Egypt); ‡ a condition of slavery (Ex. 1: 1); ‡ a place of death. ‡ to open →

 - **The Way Into** ‡ The New Land of Canaan. ‡ this was to be their own possession. This is God's purpose for us Spiritually, Colossians 1: 13. ‡ to open →

– **The Way Into** ‡ Liberty. ‡ God's purpose for Israel was that they should have liberty. They were to be a free people, a nation in their own right. We are called into liberty in Christ, John 8: 36. ‡ to open →

– **The Way Into** ‡ A New Life. ‡ God's purpose for Israel was that they should come into a New Life as opposed to the dead experience of slavery. Our new life is through the death of Christ, Hebrews 2: 14-15. ‡ to open →

– **The Way Through** ‡ The Passover – chapter 12. ‡ The blood sprinkled doorway. They were delivered by God's Almighty arm, Exodus 14: 30. ‡ All who left Egypt had to pass through the blood. Exodus 12: 7. We are delivered by the victory of the Cross - 1 Corinthians 5: 7, Colossians 1: 13. ‡ to open →

– **The Way Through** ‡ God gave the Ten Commandments. ‡ The children of Israel experienced Fellowship with God at the Tabernacle. ‡ to open →

– **The Way Through** ‡ the Cross is our door. We come out of spiritual Egypt (old life) and into our spiritual Canaan (new life), through the Cross alone. Nobody can come any other way. We must now observe John 14: 15.
