– Numbers ≠ Hebrew name means in the wilderness (we might say that the Numbers is the book of the way through [the wilderness]) ≠ all these numbers are mentioned in the book ≠ the numbers refer to - priests, carters, packers, carriers, soldiers, princes, captains and elders ≠ to open →

Slide 3



– God is orderly – ≠ the signals to move: ≠ the cloud moved by God ≠ the silver trumpets blown by the priests ≠ to open →

– God is orderly – ≠ the order of the camp: ≠ the tabernacle in the middle ≠ then the priestly tribes around it ≠ then the 12 tribes around the priests. Note; as the tribe of Levi was set aside for the service of the Tabernacle, Joseph's sons, Ephraim and Manasseh, acted as 2 tribes. ≠ to open →

– God is orderly ≠ the order of the march ≠ 1. Issachar, Judah, Zebulun. ≠ 2. Merarites and Gershonites carrying the Tabernacle structure which was erected ready for the priests ≠ 3. Reuben, Simeon, Gad. ≠ 4. the Kohathites (Priests) carrying the Holy furniture. When they first set off from Mount Sinai the Ark of the Covenant went before them. Hobab, the son of Jethro [Reuel] knew the Sinai wilderness and helped Moses. ≠ 5. Ephraim, Manasseh, Benjamin. ≠ 6. Dan, Asher, Naphtali. ≠ to open →

- The Spies ≠ One from each of the 12 tribes ≠ Caleb and Joshua gave a good report ≠ 10 spies gave a bad report ≠ Israel's unbelief and disobedience. ≠ see Numbers chapters 13 & 14 ≠ to open →
