– ‡ How to live wisely – this means to put the Lord Jesus Christ first. A very practical book. It can be said that ‡ this book is “Heavenly rules for earthly living”. ‡ to open →

– We remember that it is God ‡ who gave Solomon wisdom (1 Kings 4: 29-34) There are ‡ no stories to tell, no ‡ history. Most of the proverbs come ‡ from Solomon (chapters 1-29), some from ‡ Agur (chapter 30), and some from ‡ Lemuel (chapter 31). ‡ to open →

– Wise advice, chapter 4: 20-27 - ‡ What you say, vs.24; ‡ what you look at and see (vs.25); ‡ what you hear (vs. (20); ‡ where you walk (vs.26-27); ‡ what you are, what you think (vs.20). ‡ to open →

– Wise things – chapter 30: 25-28. ‡ The ant (vs.25); ‡ the coney or rock badger – like a rabbit, (vs.26); ‡ the locust (vs.27); ‡ the spider (vs.28) ‡ to open →

- Wise warnings. ‡ All these road signs have a red triangle, and are there to warn us. They can be disregarded at our peril. ‡ Chapter 4: 14 – Do not enter the path of the wicked, and do not walk in the way of evil. ‡ Chapter 11: 1 – Dishonest scales are an abomination to the LORD. ‡ Chapter 14: 9 – fools mock at sin. ‡ Chapter 14: 12 – there is a way that seems right to a man, but its end is the

way of death. ‡ Chapter 27: 1 – Do not boast about tomorrow, for you do not know what a day may bring forth. ‡ to open →

– Wise steps. These lead us upwards and are progressive. ‡ Chapter 1: 7 – wisdom starts with the fear of the LORD. ‡ Chapter 3: 5 – trust in the LORD with all your heart. ‡ Chapter 8: 33 – hear instruction and be wise. ‡ Chapter 18: 10 – the name of the LORD is a strong tower. ‡ Chapter 18: 24 – the LORD will not disappoint....there is a friend who sticks closer than a brother. ‡ to open →

– God's wisdom – in sending ‡ His Son to die for us. ‡ Wise choice – God chose His only begotten Son, the Lord Jesus Christ. ‡ Christ is the wisdom of God – 1 Corinthians 1: 23-24. ‡ Christ became wisdom for us – 1 Corinthians 1: 30. ‡ Chapter 8 of Proverbs shows the wisdom of God in Creation – vs.22-31. Christ was there at Creation – ‡ John chapter 1: 3 – All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made.

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
