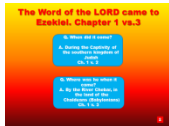

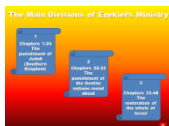
– The word of the LORD came. ‡ Where was he when it came? ‡ When did it come? ‡ to open →

– What do we know about Ezekiel? ‡ He ministered for about 22 years. ‡ He was a Priest. (1: 3) ‡ His name means- “The God who strengthens”. ‡ He prophesied at the time of the Captivity of the Southern Kingdom of Judah, with Jeremiah and Daniel. ‡ He was married – his wife died suddenly on the day the King of Babylon came against Jerusalem. (24: 15-18) ‡ to open →

– The main divisions of Ezekiel's ministry. ‡ Chapters 1-24 – the punishment of Judah (Southern Kingdom). ‡ Chapters 25-32 – the punishment of the Gentile nations round about. ‡ Chapters 33-48 – the restoration of the whole of Israel. ‡ to open →

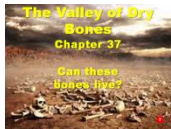
– The visions of wheels, fire, clouds etc. can all be summed up as “The Glory of the LORD”. ‡ This is shown in chapter 1: 26-28. However, ‡ the glory had been withdrawn from the Southern Kingdom of Judah. Chapters 1-24. ‡ to open →

- A message of woe. ‡ Lamentations, mourning and woe. ‡ Chapter 2: 9-10. ‡ to open →

– The valley of dry bones. ‡ Chapter 37. This refers primarily to Israel (Judah) Would they ever be a nation again? ‡ Can these bones live? Would they be resurrected? This can also refer to conversion - a soul, dead in trespasses and sins can only be made alive again through the Lord Jesus Christ. ‡ to open →

– Restoration of the land. ‡ Map showing the division between Judah and Israel (Ephraim). ‡ Chapter 11: 14-20; 37: 15-28. ‡ The promise of a united Israel once again. ‡ to open →

Slide 9



– A New City, a New Temple. ‡ The plans for the Temple are in chapters 40-43. Note the East gate and the stream coming out of it - a picture of blessing to the whole world. Compare with the mention of a tree lined stream in Revelation chapter 22. ‡ ‡, – Chapter 47: 1-12. The East Gate is reserved for the Prince – chapter 44. ‡ to open →

- The East Gate ‡ and the outflowing blessing. ‡ This reminds us of the cross and all the blessings flowing from it. ‡ The trees along the river will bare fruit ‡ The LORD is there – Chapter 48: 35. ‡ to open →
