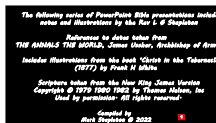
The Tabernacle – Part 1 - Background

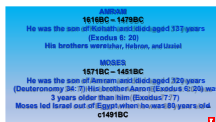
Isaac † life span, † length of life, † born when his father Abraham was 100 years old, † Isaac married Rebekah when he was 40 years old (Genesis 25: 20) (yellow line), † Jacob, † life span, † length of life, † born when his father was 60 years old, † his name was changed to Israel, and he was 137 years old when he died: he lived 17 years in Egypt . † to open →

Levi, † life span, † length of life, † he was the third son of Israel (Genesis 29 etc) (yellow line), † Kohath, † length of life, † dates of his life span unknown. † His brothers were Gershon and Merari. † to open →

Aram, † life span, † length of life, † his brothers were Izhar, Hebron and Uzziel, (yellow line), † Moses, † life span, † length of life, † he was three years younger than Aaron, his brother, Moses led the children of Israel out of Egypt, aged 80. † to open →

The time spent in slavery, † key verse = Galatians 3: 16-17, † The Margin re Exodus 12: 40 (NKJV) shows the 430 years sojourning includes Caanan(this is according to the Samaritan Pentateuch and the Septuagint). † The call to Abraham was – c1922BC, † the giving of the law to Moses was c1492BC, † =430 years. † Call of Abraham – c1922BC; Jacob went to Egypt – c1706BC = c215 years. † Jacob went to Egypt c1706BC; giving of the Law to Moses c1492BC = c215 years. † to open →

Leaving Egypt, ‡ the children of Israel were a **REDEEMED** people, ‡ all had to pass the blood marked door (door in the background), ‡ all had to pass through the Red Sea, and ‡ all left a land of sin and slavery. ‡ summed up in the words of Deuteronomy 6: 23. ‡ We are redeemed by the blood of the Lord Jesus Christ, shed on Calvary's cross (Cross appears)
