Scripture texts used in Part 1 – Background

Slide 3

Genesis 17: 5 – “No longer shall your name be Abram, but your name shall be Abraham; for I have made you a father of many nations.”

Genesis 15:7 – “Then He said to me, ‘I am the LORD, who brought you out of Ur of the Chaldeans, to give you this land to inherit it’.”

Genesis 25: 7 + 9 – “⁷This is the sum of the years of Abraham’s life which he lived: one hundred and seventy-five years...⁹And his sons Isaac and Ishmael buried him in the cave of Machpelah, which is before Mamre, in the field of Ephron the son of Zohar the Hittite.”

Genesis 12: 2-3 – “²I will make you a great nation; I will bless you and make your name great; and you shall be a blessing. ³I will bless those who bless you, and I will curse those who curse you; and in your family all the families of the earth shall be blessed.”

Acts 7: 2-3 – (*Stephen said*) “... ²the God of glory appeared to our father Abraham when he was in Mesopotamia (*Ur of the Chaldees*), before he dwelt in Haran, ³and said to him, ‘Get out of your country and from your relatives, and come to a land that I will show you.’ “

Genesis 12: 1 – “Now the LORD had said to Abram: ‘Get out of your country, from your family and from your father’s house, to a land that I will show you’.”

Genesis 12: 10 – “Now there was a famine in the land, and Abram went down to Egypt to dwell there, for the famine was severe in the land.”

Genesis 13: 3 – “And he went on his journey from the South as far as Bethel, to the place where his tent had been at the beginning, between Bethel and Ai.”

Genesis 35: 28 – “Now the days of Isaac were one hundred and eighty years.”

Genesis 21: 5 – “Now Abraham was one hundred years old when his son Isaac was born to him.”

Genesis 25: 20 – “Isaac was forty years old when he took Rebekah as wife, the daughter of Bethuel...”

Genesis 47: 28 – “...So the length of Jacob’s life was one hundred and forty-seven years.”

Genesis 25: 26 - 2... so his name was called Jacob. Isaac was sixty years old when she (*Rebekah*) bore them (*the twins*)”

Genesis 35: 10 – “And God said to him, ‘Your name is Jacob; your name shall not be called Jacob anymore, but Israel shall be your name.’ So He called his name Israel.”

Genesis 47: 28 – “ And Jacob lived in the land of Egypt seventeen years. So the length of Jacob’s life was one hundred and forty-seven years.”

Exodus 6:16 – “... and the years of the life of Levi were one hundred and thirty-seven.”

Exodus 6: 18 – “...And the years of the life of Kohath were one hundred and thirty-three years.”

Exodus 6: 18 – “And the sons of Kohath were Amram, Izhar, Hebron and Uzziel.”

Exodus 6: 20 – “...And the years of the life of Amram were one hundred and thirty-seven years.”

Deuteronomy 34: 7 – “Moses was one hundred and twenty years old when he died.”

Exodus 7: 7 – “..and Moses was eighty years old and Aaron eighty-three years old when they spoke to Pharaoh.”

Exodus 1: 7 – “But the children of Israel were fruitful and increased abundantly, multiplied and grew exceedingly mighty; and the land was filled with them.”

Exodus 1: 20 – “Therefore God dealt well with the midwives, and the people multiplied and grew very mighty.”

Exodus 3: 10 – “*And the LORD said*, “Come now, therefore, and I will send you to Pharaoh that you may bring My people, the children of Israel out of Egypt.”

Numbers 14: 33 – “And your sons shall be shepherds in the wilderness forty years, and bear the brunt of your infidelity, until your carcasses are consumed in the wilderness.”

Exodus 12: 7 – “And they shall take some of the blood and put it on the two doorposts and on the lintel of the houses where they eat it. (*the Passover*)”

Exodus 14: 22 – “So the children of Israel went into the midst of the sea on the dry ground, and the waters were a wall to them on their right hand and on their left.”

Exodus 14: 30 – “So the LORD saved Israel out of the hand of the Egyptians ...”

Deuteronomy 6: 23 – “Then He brought us out from there, that He might bring us in , to give us a land of which He swore to our fathers.”

John 14: 6 – “Jesus said to him (*Thomas, the Disciple*), ‘I am the way, the truth , and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.’”
