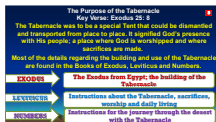

'The Purpose of the Tabernacle' Key Verse = Exodus 25: 8. ⌘ The Tabernacle was to be a special tent..etc. ⌘ Most of the details regarding the building and use of the Tabernacle, are found in the Books of Exodus, Leviticus and Numbers. ⌘ Exodus = The Exodus from Egypt & the building of the Tabernacle ⌘ Leviticus = Instructions re sacrifices, worship and daily living ⌘ Numbers = instructions for the journey through the wilderness ⌘ to open →

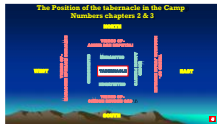

⌘ Map of Sinai peninsular shown, ⌘ blue circle shows position of Mount Sinai. What happened at Mount Sinai? ⌘ God gave Moses the Ten Commandments, ⌘ He gave the pattern (PLANS GIVEN) "according to the pattern which was shown you on the mount" (Sinai), Exodus 25:9, 40; 26: 20; Numbers 8: 4;

Acts 7:44; Hebrews 8:5 ✚ PLANS FULFILLED - “As the LORD commanded Moses” – Exodus chapters 35-40; Leviticus chapter 8:36 God reminds Moses that the building was to be exactly as He had told him on Mount Sinai. Moses obeyed and proceeded to build the Tabernacle – a lesson here for us – God expects wholehearted obedience to His commands c/f – “If you love me keep my commandments” (John 14: 15). ✚ to open →

The position of the Tabernacle in the camp – Numbers chapter 2-3. ✚ position of the Tabernacle, ✚ orientation - North, East, South, West ✚ position of the 12 tribes around the Tabernacle, ✚ position of the camping of the Levites around the Tabernacle. ✚ to open →

The Plan of the Tabernacle ✚ the outer court shape is drawn, ✚ the orientation is shown – North, East, South, West, ✚ position of the entrance curtain, ✚ the Tabernacle itself - the Holy Place, and then the most Holy Place, ✚ the position of the Ark of the Covenant, ✚ position of the Altar of Incense, ✚ position of the Table of Shewbread, ✚ position of the Candlestick, ✚ position of the Laver, ✚ position of the Brasen Altar. ✚ Exodus 40: 1-33 for the fulfilment of God's instructions. ✚ to open →

Metals - ✚ In the AV of the Bible the word BRASS is used... ✚ Today, BRASS is known as an alloy of COPPER and ZINC. ✚ In the NKJV of the Bible, the word BRONZE is used...See Numbers 21: 4-9 and John 3: 14, relating to the fiery serpent made by Moses and set up on a pole. ✚ Today, BRONZE is known as an alloy of COPPER and TIN. ✚ In these presentations, the word BRONZE is used. ✚ to open →

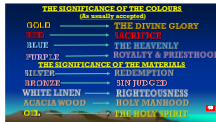

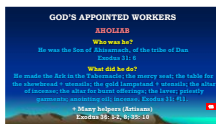
Materials used in the construction of the Tabernacle. ‡ These are listed in Exodus 25: 1-7. ‡ These items float onto the screen. ‡ to open

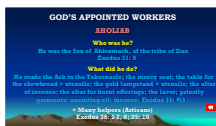
The significance of the colours of the materials ‡ Gold etc, ‡ The significance of the materials - Silver etc. ‡ to open →

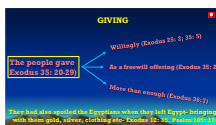

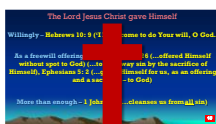
