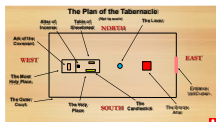

A **reminder** of God's plans of the Tabernacle given to Moses. In this part we will deal with the outer court, the Laver, the Bronze Altar and the structure of the Tabernacle itself. In the next part we will talk about the items placed inside the Tabernacle. ⌘ to open →

The Pattern of the Tabernacle. ⌘ Plans given in detail by God to Moses – starting with the Ark of the Covenant – Exodus chapters 25-31. ⌘ Plans carried out in detail by Moses – Exodus chapters 35-40. ⌘ The Tabernacle speaks to the Christian believer of the LORD JESUS CHRIST – the book of Hebrews gives many examples of how CHRIST fulfilled the service of the priestly office. ⌘ The Authority for using the Tabernacle for Spiritual lessons – Hebrews 8: 5; 9: 8; 10: 19-22. ⌘ Note – one cubit

was the measurement from the tip of the big finger to the elbow, which is about ½ a metre. ‡ to open →

Acacia Wood – MENTIONED 26 TIMES IN THE BOOK OF Exodus, and once in Deuteronomy - ‡ drawing of an Acacia tree - ‡ Its use in the construction of the Tabernacle. ‡ to open →

The outer court - ‡ 20 Pillars on the North and South sides... ‡ 100 cubits long by ‡ 5 cubits high. ‡ 10 Pillars on the West and East side... ‡ 15 cubits wide either side of the entrance curtain. ‡ The entrance curtain was 20 cubits wide. ‡ Details are found in Exodus 27: 9-19. ‡ The entrance curtain was easily seen... ‡ to open →

The Altar of Burnt Offering (Bronze Altar) ‡ Arrow showing the Altar. ‡ The Position of the Altar. ‡ The purpose of the Altar. ‡ to open →

The Altar of burnt offering – the details. ‡ Size etc. ‡ 4 Bronze rings etc. ‡ A horn on each corner. ‡ Grating an four rings etc. ‡ Pans and shovels etc. ‡ to open →

The Altar of burnt Offering – the teaching - ‡ The horns were symbolic of power (Deuteronomy 33:17 etc). ‡ The Altar shows divine judgement (Hebrews 9 etc.). ‡ The fire was never to go out (Leviticus 6: 13). ‡ The Altar represents the Cross ‡ to open →

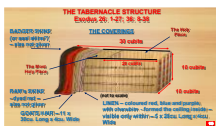

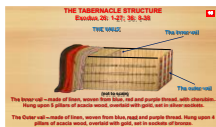
≠ The Boards ≠ Each Board – dimensions. ≠ Position of the Boards

The Tabernacle structure ≠ The Sockets for the Boards. ≠ Made of Silver (Exodus 38: 24-28). ≠ Total of 100 sockets. ≠ Note – sockets for the entrance to the Holy Place were made of Bronze. to open →

✚ The Veils - ✚ The inner veil. ✚ The outer veil. ✚ to open →

The Eastern entrance Veil. ✚ Materials and Colours all remind us of the Lord Jesus Christ. ✚ List of colours and materials. ✚ The Cross. ✚ John 14: 6, John 10: 9.
