

THE TABERNACLE POWERPOINT PRESENTATION

Scripture texts used in Part 3 – Construction of the Tabernacle – outside

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Hebrews 8: 5 – “...who serve the copy and shadow of the heavenly things, as Moses was divinely instructed when he was about to make the Tabernacle.”

Hebrews 9: 8-9 – “...⁸ the Holy Spirit indicating this (*the High Priest duties*) that the way into the Holiest of All was not yet made manifest while the first Tabernacle was still standing. ⁹It was symbolic for the present time in which both gifts and sacrifices are offered which cannot make him who performed the service perfect in regard to the conscience.”

Hebrews 10: 19-22 – “¹⁹Therefore, brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of Jesus, ²⁰by a new and living way which He consecrated for us, through the veil, that is, His flesh, ²¹and *having* a High Priest over the house of God, ²²let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.”

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Exodus 27: 4-8 – “⁴You shall make a grate for it, a network of bronze; and on the network you shall make four bronze rings at its four corners. ⁵You shall put it under the rim of the altar beneath, that the network may be midway up the altar. ⁶And you shall make poles for the altar, poles of acacia wood, and overlay them with bronze. ⁷The poles shall be put in the rings, and the poles shall be on the two sides of the altar to bear it. ⁸You shall make it hollow with boards; as it was shown you on the mountain, so shall they make *it*.?”

Exodus 38: 1-7 - ¹He made the altar of burnt offering of acacia wood; five cubits *was* its length and five cubits its width—*it was square*—and its height *was* three cubits. ² He made its horns on its four corners; the horns were *of one piece* with it. And he overlaid it with bronze. ³He made all the utensils for the altar: the pans, the shovels, the basins, the forks, and the firepans; all its utensils he made of bronze. ⁴ And he made a grate of bronze network for the altar, under its rim, midway from the bottom. ⁵He cast four rings for the four corners of the bronze grating, *as* holders for the poles. ⁶And he made the poles of acacia wood, and overlaid them with bronze. ⁷Then he put the poles into the rings on the sides of the altar, with which to bear it. He made the altar hollow with boards.”

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Various quotes from Exodus 27, as above.

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Deuteronomy 33: 17 – “His glory *is like* a firstborn bull, and his horns *like* the horns of the wild ox; Together with them he shall push the peoples to the ends of the earth...”

1 Kings 22: 11 – “Now Zedekiah the son of Chenaanah had made horns of iron for himself; and he said, “Thus says the LORD: ‘With these you shall gore the Syrians until they are destroyed’.”

Jeremiah 48: 25 – “The horn of Moab is cut off, and his arm is broken,” says the LORD.”

Hebrews 9: 22 – “And according to the law almost all things are purified with blood, and without shedding of blood there is no remission.”

Hebrews 10: 4 – “For *it is* not possible that the blood of bulls and goats could take away sins.”

Hebrews 10: 12 - But this Man, after He had offered one sacrifice for sins forever, sat down at the right hand of God,

2 Corinthians 5: 21 – “For He made Him who knew no sin *to be* sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.”

Leviticus 6: 13 – “A fire shall always be burning on the altar; it shall never go out.”

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Exodus 30: 18 – “You shall also make a laver of bronze, with its base also of bronze, for washing. You shall put it between the tabernacle of meeting and the altar. And you shall put water in it...”

Exodus 30: 19-21 – “¹⁹for Aaron and his sons shall wash their hands and their feet in water from it. ²⁰When they go into the tabernacle of meeting, or when they come near the altar to minister, to burn an offering made by fire to the LORD, they shall wash with water, lest they die. ²¹So they shall wash their hands and their feet, lest they die. And it shall be a statute forever to them—to him and his descendants throughout their generations.”

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Exodus 38: 8 – “He made the laver of bronze and its base of bronze, from the bronze mirrors of the serving women who assembled at the door of the tabernacle of meeting.”

1 Peter 2: 5 – “..you also, as living stones, are being built up a spiritual house, a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.”

1 Peter 2: 9 – “But you *are* a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light;”

Revelation 1: 5-6 – “⁵and from Jesus Christ, the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler over the kings of the earth. To Him who loved us and washed us

from our sins in His own blood, ⁶ and has made us king's and priests to His God and Father, to Him *be* glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen."

Revelation 5: 10 – "And have made us kings^l and priests to our God; and we shall reign on the earth."

Ephesians 5: 26 – "...that He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the word,"

John 15: 3 – "You are already clean because of the word which I have spoken to you."

John 13: 10 – "Jesus said to him, "He who is bathed needs only to wash *his* feet, but is completely clean; and you are clean, but not all of you."

Psalms 24: 3 - 5 – "Who may ascend into the hill of the LORD? Or who may stand in His holy place? ⁴ He who has clean hands and a pure heart, Who has not lifted up his soul to an idol, Nor sworn deceitfully.⁵ He shall receive blessing from the LORD, And righteousness from the God of his salvation

Psalms 119: 9 – "How can a young man cleanse his way? By taking heed according to Your word."
