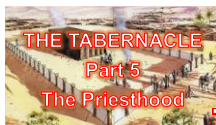

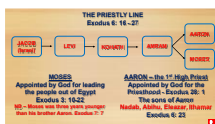

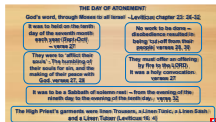
Instructions for making the Priests' garments. ‡ Picture of a priest. ‡ Shows the various garments. ‡ All garments first worn at their consecration – Exodus 29. ‡ For Glory and for Beauty – Exodus 28: 2, 40 ‡ to open →

The Day of Atonement. ‡ It was an annual day..etc. ‡ Picture of a priest, about to enter the Holy of Holies. ‡ The High Priest. ‡ The Great High Priest – Hebrews 9: 12, 24. ‡ to open →

The Day of Atonement. ‡ Bible Reference – Leviticus 23: 26 – 32. ‡ It was held on the tenth day .. verse 27, ‡ they were to afflict their souls – verses 27, 29. ‡ No work to be done – verses 28, 30. ‡ they must offer an offering – verse 27. ‡ It was to be a Sabbath of Solemn Rest – verse 32. ‡ The High Priest's garments Leviticus 16: 4. ‡ to open →

Christ's Priestly work accomplished + picture of the High Priest about to enter the Holy of Holies. ‡ Every Priest stands ministering daily... Hebrews 10:11. ‡ But this MAN, after he had offered one sacrifice... Hebrews 10: 12 + Cross appears.
