

THE TABERNACLE POWERPOINT PRESENTATION

Scripture texts used in Part 5 – The Priesthood

Slide 3

Exodus 7: 7 – “And Moses *was* eighty years old and Aaron eighty-three years old when they spoke to Pharaoh.”

Exodus 28: 1 - “Now take Aaron your brother, and his sons with him, from among the children of Israel, that he may minister to Me as priest, Aaron *and* Aaron’s sons: Nadab, Abihu, Eleazar, and Ithamar.”

Exodus 6: 23 – “Aaron took to himself Elisheba, daughter of Amminadab, sister of Nahshon, as wife; and she bore him Nadab, Abihu, Eleazar, and Ithamar.”

Hebrews 9: 6 – “Now when these things had been thus prepared, the priests always went into the first part of the tabernacle, performing the services.”

Leviticus 1: 7 – “The sons of Aaron the priest shall put fire on the altar, and lay the wood in order on the fire.”

Leviticus 2: 3 – “The rest of the grain offering *shall be* Aaron’s and his sons’. *It is* most holy of the offerings to the LORD made by fire.”

Leviticus 6: 9 - “⁹“Command Aaron and his sons, saying, ‘This *is* the law of the burnt offering: The burnt offering *shall be* on the hearth upon the altar all night until morning, and the fire of the altar shall be kept burning on it. ¹⁰ And the priest shall put on his linen garment, and his linen trousers he shall put on his body, and take up the ashes of the burnt offering which the fire has consumed on the altar, and he shall put them beside the altar. ¹¹ Then he shall take off his garments, put on other garments, and carry the ashes outside the camp to a clean place.”

Exodus 30: 10 – “And Aaron shall make atonement upon its horns once a year with the blood of the sin offering of atonement; once a year he shall make atonement upon it throughout your generations. *It is* most holy to the LORD.”

Hebrews 9: 7 – “But into the second part the high priest *went* alone once a year, not without blood, which he offered for himself and *for* the people’s sins *committed* in ignorance”

Numbers 1: 49-51 - “⁴⁹“Only the tribe of Levi you shall not number, nor take a census of them among the children of Israel; ⁵⁰ but you shall appoint the Levites over the tabernacle of the Testimony, over all its furnishings, and over all things that belong to it; they shall carry the tabernacle and all its furnishings; they shall attend to it and camp around the tabernacle. ⁵¹ And when the tabernacle is to go forward, the Levites shall take it down; and when the tabernacle is to be set up, the Levites shall set it up. The outsider who comes near shall be put to death.”

Exodus 28: 2 – “And you shall make holy garments for Aaron your brother, for glory and for beauty.”

Exodus 28: 40 - “For Aaron’s sons you shall make tunics, and you shall make sashes for them. And you shall make hats for them, for glory and beauty.:

Leviticus 23: 26-32 – “²⁶And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying: ²⁷“Also the tenth *day* of this seventh month *shall be* the Day of Atonement. It shall be a holy convocation for you; you shall afflict your souls, and offer an offering made by fire to the LORD. ²⁸And you shall do no work on that same day, for it *is* the Day of Atonement, to make atonement for you before the LORD your God. ²⁹For any person who is not afflicted *in soul* on that same day shall be cut off from his people. ³⁰And any person who does any work on that same day, that person I will destroy from among his people. ³¹You shall do no manner of work; *it shall be* a statute forever throughout your generations in all your dwellings. ³²It *shall be* to you a sabbath of *solemn* rest, and you shall afflict your souls; on the ninth *day* of the month at evening, from evening to evening, you shall celebrate your sabbath.”

Leviticus 16: 4 – “He shall put the holy linen tunic and the linen trousers on his body; he shall be girded with a linen sash, and with the linen turban he shall be attired. These *are* holy garments. Therefore he shall wash his body in water, and put them on.”

Hebrews 10: 11-12 – “¹¹And every priest stands ministering daily and offering repeatedly the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins. ¹²But this Man, after He had offered one sacrifice for sins forever, sat down at the right hand of God,”
