Scripture texts used in Part 7 – The Wilderness Journey

Exodus 13: 17-18 – “¹⁷Then it came to pass, when Pharaoh had let the people go, that God did not lead them *by way* of the land of the Philistines, although that *was* near; for God said, “Lest perhaps the people change their minds when they see war, and return to Egypt.” ¹⁸So God led the people around *by way* of the wilderness of the Red Sea. And the children of Israel went up in orderly ranks out of the land of Egypt.”

Numbers 9: 16 – “So it was always: the cloud covered it *by day*, and the appearance of fire by night.”

Number 10: 2 - “Make two silver trumpets for yourself; you shall make them of hammered work; you shall use them for calling the congregation and for directing the movement of the camps.”

Numbers 7: 9 - “But to the sons of Kohath he gave none, because theirs *was* the service of the holy things, *which* they carried on their shoulders.”

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Numbers 7: 7 – “Two carts and four oxen he gave to the sons of Gershon, according to their service;”

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Numbers 7: 8 – “..and four carts and eight oxen he gave to the sons of Merari, according to their service, under the authority of Ithamar the son of Aaron the priest.”

Isaiah 53: 6 – “All we like sheep have gone astray; We have turned, every one, to his own way; And the LORD has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.”

John 1: 29 – “The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, “Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!”

John 3: 14 – “And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of Man be lifted up,”

1 Corinthians 15: 51-52 – “⁵¹ Behold, I tell you a mystery: We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed— ⁵²in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.”
