

THE TABERNACLE POWERPOINT PRESENTATION

Scripture texts used in Part 8 – What Happened Next

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Deuteronomy 32: 48-52 – “⁴⁸ Then the LORD spoke to Moses that very same day, saying: ⁴⁹ “Go up this mountain of the Abarim, Mount Nebo, which *is* in the land of Moab, across from Jericho; view the land of Canaan, which I give to the children of Israel as a possession; ⁵⁰ and die on the mountain which you ascend, and be gathered to your people, just as Aaron your brother died on Mount Hor and was gathered to his people; ⁵¹ because you trespassed against Me among the children of Israel at the waters of Meribah Kadesh, in the Wilderness of Zin, because you did not hallow Me in the midst of the children of Israel.”

Joshua 5: 10 – “Now the children of Israel camped in Gilgal, and kept the Passover on the fourteenth day of the month at twilight on the plains of Jericho.”

Joshua 5: 12 – “Then the manna ceased on the day after they had eaten the produce of the land; and the children of Israel no longer had manna, but they ate the food of the land of Canaan that year.”

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Joshua 18: 1 – “Now the whole congregation of the children of Israel assembled together at Shiloh, and set up the tabernacle of meeting there. And the land was subdued before them.”

Judges 18: 31 – “So they set up for themselves Micah's carved image which he made, all the time that the house of God was in Shiloh.”

Psalms 78: 60 – “So that He forsook the tabernacle of Shiloh, The tent He had placed among men,”

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1 Samuel 7: 1-2 – “¹ Then the men of Kirjath Jearim came and took the ark of the LORD, and brought it into the house of Abinadab on the hill, and consecrated Eleazar his son to keep the ark of the LORD. ² So it was that the ark remained in Kirjath Jearim a long time; it was there twenty years. And all the house of Israel lamented after the LORD.”

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1 Samuel 7: 3-6 – “³ Then Samuel spoke to all the house of Israel, saying, “If you return to the LORD with all your hearts, *then* put away the foreign gods and the Ashtoreths from among you, and prepare your hearts for the LORD, and serve Him only; and He will deliver you from the hand of the Philistines.” ⁴ So the children of Israel put away the Baals and the Ashtoreths, and served the LORD only. ⁵ And Samuel said, “Gather all Israel to Mizpah, and I will pray to the LORD for you.” ⁶ So they gathered together at Mizpah, drew water, and poured *it* out before the LORD. And they fasted that day, and

said there, "We have sinned against the LORD." And Samuel judged the children of Israel at Mizpah."

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2 Samuel 6: 17 – "So they brought the ark of the LORD, and set it in its place in the midst of the tabernacle that David had erected for it. Then David offered burnt offerings and peace offerings before the LORD."

1 Chronicles 16: 39-40 – "³⁹and Zadok the priest and his brethren the priests, before the tabernacle of the LORD at the ^[a]high place that was at Gibeon, ⁴⁰to offer burnt offerings to the LORD on the altar of burnt offering regularly morning and evening, and *to do* according to all that is written in the Law of the LORD which He commanded Israel"

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1 Chronicles 28: 11-12 – "¹¹Then David gave his son Solomon the plans for the vestibule, its houses, its treasuries, its upper chambers, its inner chambers, and the place of the mercy seat; ¹²and the plans for all that he had by the Spirit, of the courts of the house of the LORD, of all the chambers all around, of the treasuries of the house of God, and of the treasuries for the dedicated things;"

2 Chronicles 3: 1-3 – "¹Now Solomon began to build the house of the LORD at Jerusalem on Mount Moriah, where *the LORD* had appeared to his father David, at the place that David had prepared on the threshing floor of Ornan the Jebusite. ²And he began to build on the second *day* of the second month in the fourth year of his reign. ³This is the foundation which Solomon laid for building the house of God: The length was sixty cubits (by cubits according to the former measure) and the width twenty cubits.

1 Corinthians 3: 11 – "For no other foundation can anyone lay than that which is laid, which is Jesus Christ."

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1 Kings 6: 1, 38 – "And it came to pass in the four hundred and eightieth year after the children of Israel had come out of the land of Egypt, in the fourth year of Solomon's reign over Israel, in the month of Ziv, which *is* the second month, that he began to build the house of the LORD. ³⁸And in the eleventh year, in the month of Bul, which is the eighth month, the house was finished in all its details and according to all its plans. So he was seven years in building it."

1 Kings 8: 4 – "Then they brought up the ark of the LORD, the tabernacle of meeting, and all the holy furnishings that *were* in the tabernacle. The priests and the Levites brought them up."

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2 Kings 24: 12-13 – “¹² Then Jehoiachin king of Judah, his mother, his servants, his princes, and his officers went out to the king of Babylon; and the king of Babylon, in the eighth year of his reign, took him prisoner.¹³ And he carried out from there all the treasures of the house of the LORD and the treasures of the king’s house, and he cut in pieces all the articles of gold which Solomon king of Israel had made in the temple of the LORD, as the LORD had said.”

Jeremiah 20: 5 – “Moreover I will deliver all the wealth of this city, all its produce, and all its precious things; all the treasures of the kings of Judah I will give into the hand of their enemies, who will plunder them, seize them, and carry them to Babylon.”

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2 Kings 25: 9 – “He burned the house of the LORD and the king’s house; all the houses of Jerusalem, that is, all the houses of the great, he burned with fire.”

Jeremiah 39: 8 – “And the Chaldeans burned the king’s house and the houses of the people with fire, and broke down the walls of Jerusalem.”

Jeremiah 52: 12 – 14 – “¹² Now in the fifth month, on the tenth *day* of the month (which was the nineteenth year of King Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon), Nebuzaradan, the captain of the guard, *who* served the king of Babylon, came to Jerusalem. ¹³ He burned the house of the LORD and the king’s house; all the houses of Jerusalem, that is, all the houses of the great, he burned with fire. ¹⁴ And all the army of the Chaldeans *who were* with the captain of the guard broke down all the walls of Jerusalem all around.”

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Jeremiah 3: 16 - “Then it shall come to pass, when you are multiplied and increased in the land in those days,” says the LORD, “that they will say no more, ‘The ark of the covenant of the LORD.’ It shall not come to mind, nor shall they remember it, nor shall they visit *it*, nor shall it be made anymore.”

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Ephesians 5: 23 – “For the husband is head of the wife, as also Christ is head of the church; and He is the Savior of the body”

John 14: 2 – “In My Father’s house are many mansions; if *it were* not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.”

John 14: 6 – “Jesus said to him, “I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.”

John 14: 15 - “If you love Me, keep My commandments.

John 4: 23 - "If you love Me, keep My commandments."

Hebrews 9: 22 – "And according to the law almost all things are purified with blood, and without shedding of blood there is no remission."

Matthew 28: 20 – "...teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, *even* to the end of the age." Amen."

Philippians 4: 19 – "And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus."

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Hebrews 6: 9 – "But, beloved, we are confident of better things concerning you, yes, things that accompany salvation, though we speak in this manner."

Hebrews 7: 5-7 – "⁵..And indeed those who are of the sons of Levi, who receive the priesthood, have a commandment to receive tithes from the people according to the law, that is, from their brethren, though they have come from the loins of Abraham; ⁶but he whose genealogy is not derived from them received tithes from Abraham and blessed him who had the promises. ⁷Now beyond all contradiction the lesser is blessed by the better."

Hebrews 7: 19 – "...for the law made nothing perfect; on the other hand, *there is the* bringing in of a better hope, through which we draw near to God."

Hebrews 7: 22 – "... by so much more Jesus has become a ^[a]surety of a better covenant."

Hebrews 8: 6 – "But now He has obtained a more excellent ministry, inasmuch as He is also Mediator of a better covenant, which was established on better promises."

Hebrews 9: 23 – "Therefore *it was* necessary that the copies of the things in the heavens should be purified with these, but the heavenly things themselves with better sacrifices than these."

Hebrews 10: 34 – "... for you had compassion on me in my chains, and joyfully accepted the plundering of your goods, knowing that you have a better and an enduring possession for yourselves in heaven."

Hebrews 11: 16 – "But now they desire a better, that is, a heavenly *country*. Therefore God is not ashamed to be called their God, for He has prepared a city for them."

Hebrews 1: 35 – "Women received their dead raised to life again. Others were tortured, not accepting deliverance, that they might obtain a better resurrection."

Hebrews 11: 40 – "God having provided something better for us, that they should not be made perfect apart from us."
