| ACTS 13: 14-52             | Antioch in Pisidia - a region in Turkey | Paul and Barnabas preach to Jews in the synagogue. They also preach to the Gentiles, who rejoice at hearing the Word of God. The Jews raised up persecution against them so they flee to →                       |
| ACTS 14: 1-5               | Iconium                                 | They preach in the synagogue, but persecution, by both Jews and Gentiles, forces them to flee to →                                                                                                               |
| ACTS 14: 5-19              | Lystra – a city in Lycaonia             | They preach the Gospel, a cripple is healed, Paul and Barnabas are treated as gods. Jews arrive from Antioch and Iconium to stir up trouble. Paul is stoned, and recovers. Next day, Paul & Barnabas depart to → |
| ACTS 14: 20-21             | Derbe – a city in Lycaonia              | They preach the gospel and teach many. they return to →                                                                                                                                                          |
| ACTS 14: 21-24             | Lystra<br>Iconium<br>Antioch            | They encourage and teach the disciples, they fast and pray with the believers. They appoint elders in every city. Passing through Pisidia, they come to →                                                        |
| ACTS 14: 25                | Perga in the region of Pamphylia        | They preach the Word and proceed to Attalia, and then on to →                                                                                                                                                    |
| ACTS 14: 26-28             | Antioch in Syria                        | The Church gathers together to hear what God had done, and how God had given them opportunity to preach to the Gentiles.                                                                                         |

Between the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> missionary journeys, Paul spent some time in Antioch (in Syria), and in Jerusalem, where he met the Jerusalem Council. Read: Acts 15: 1-35.
