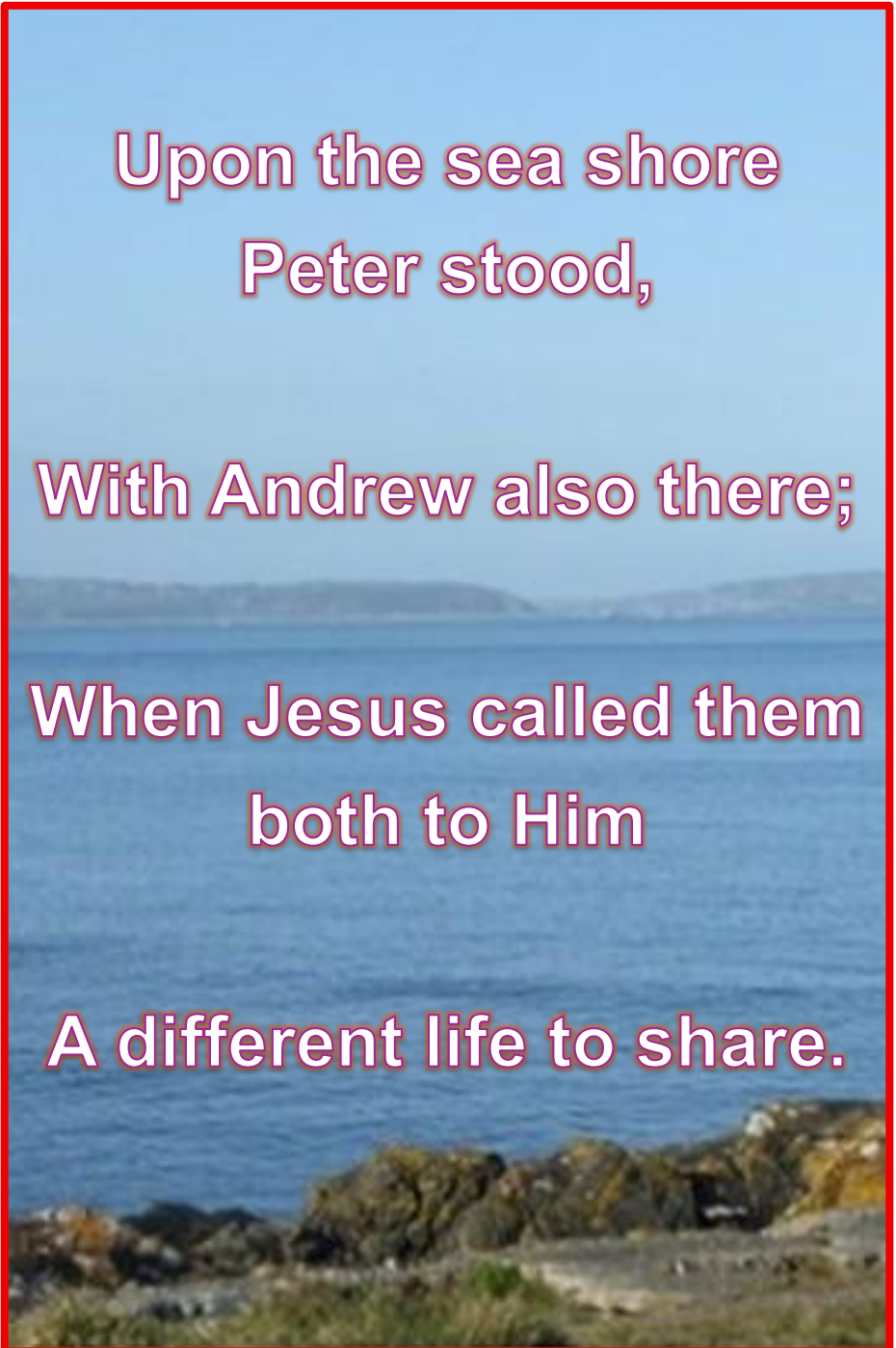


**TO HELP ME

A different life to share.

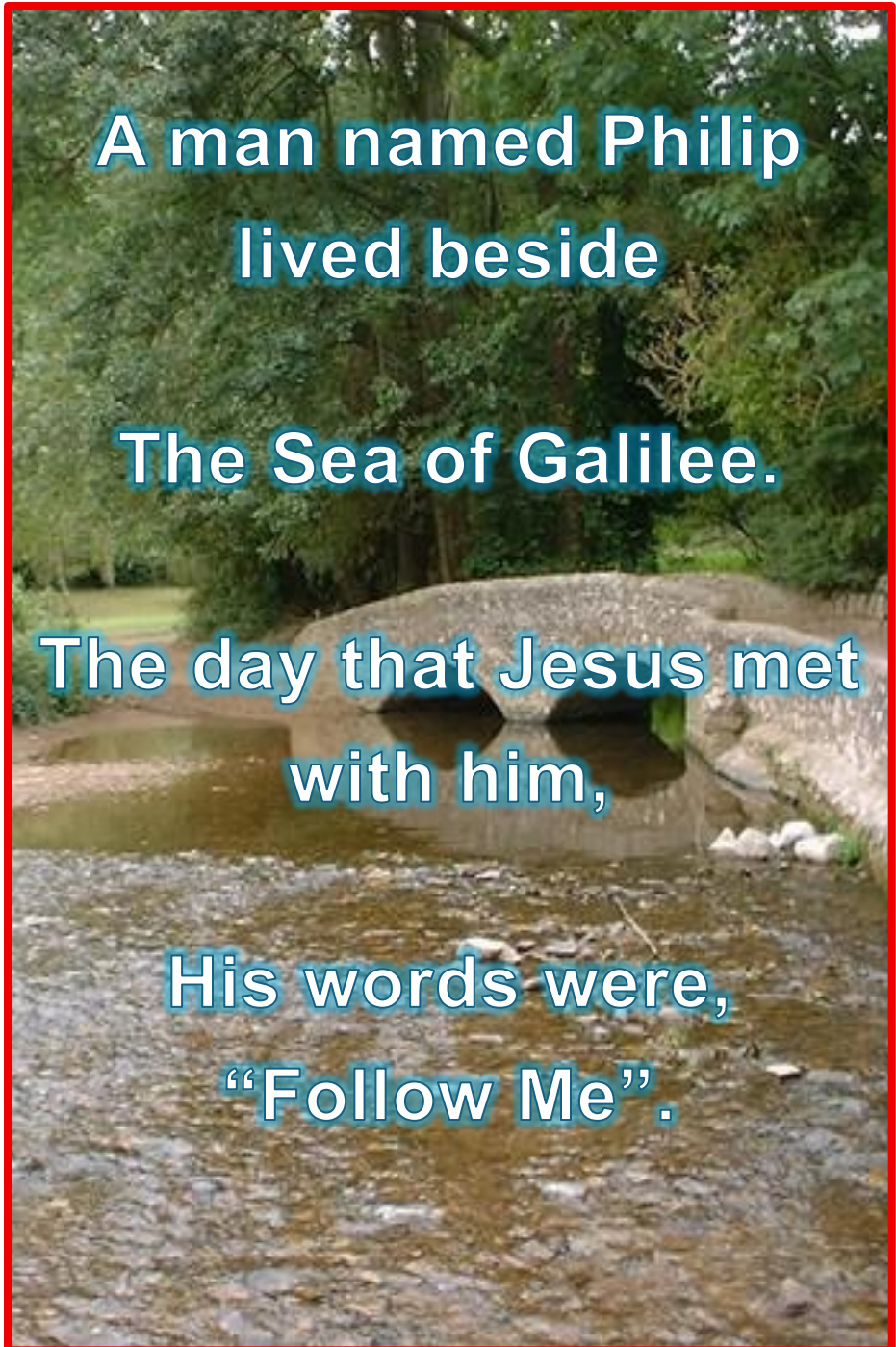

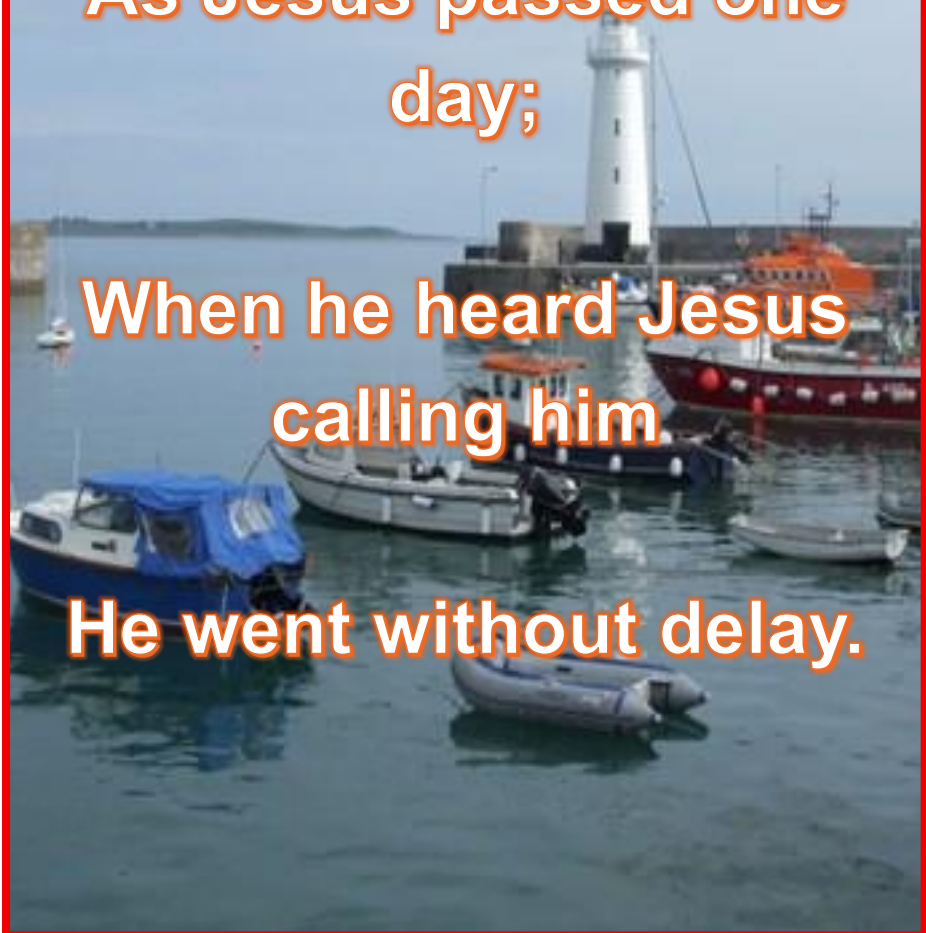
His words were,

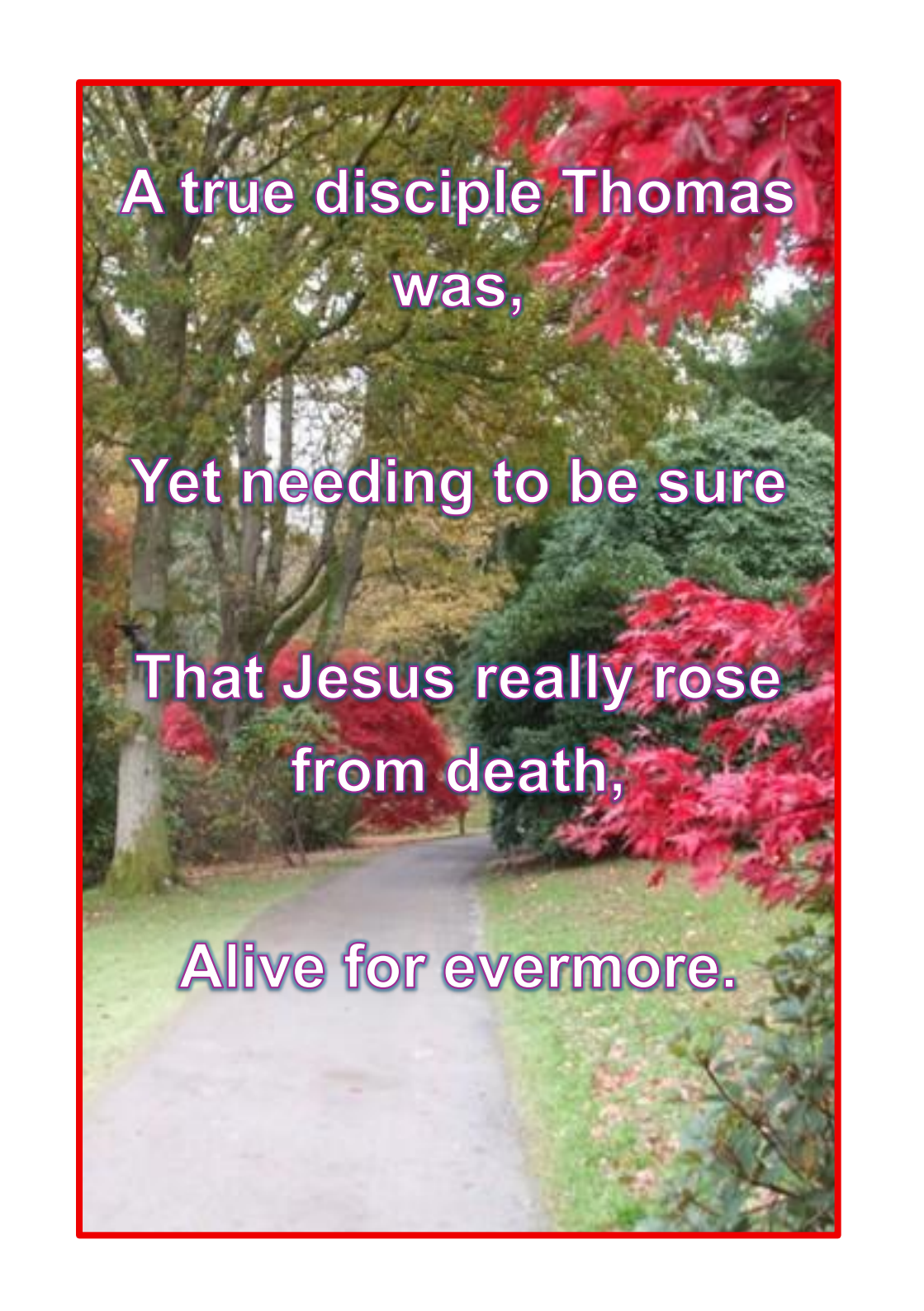
**Collecting taxes,

He went without delay.



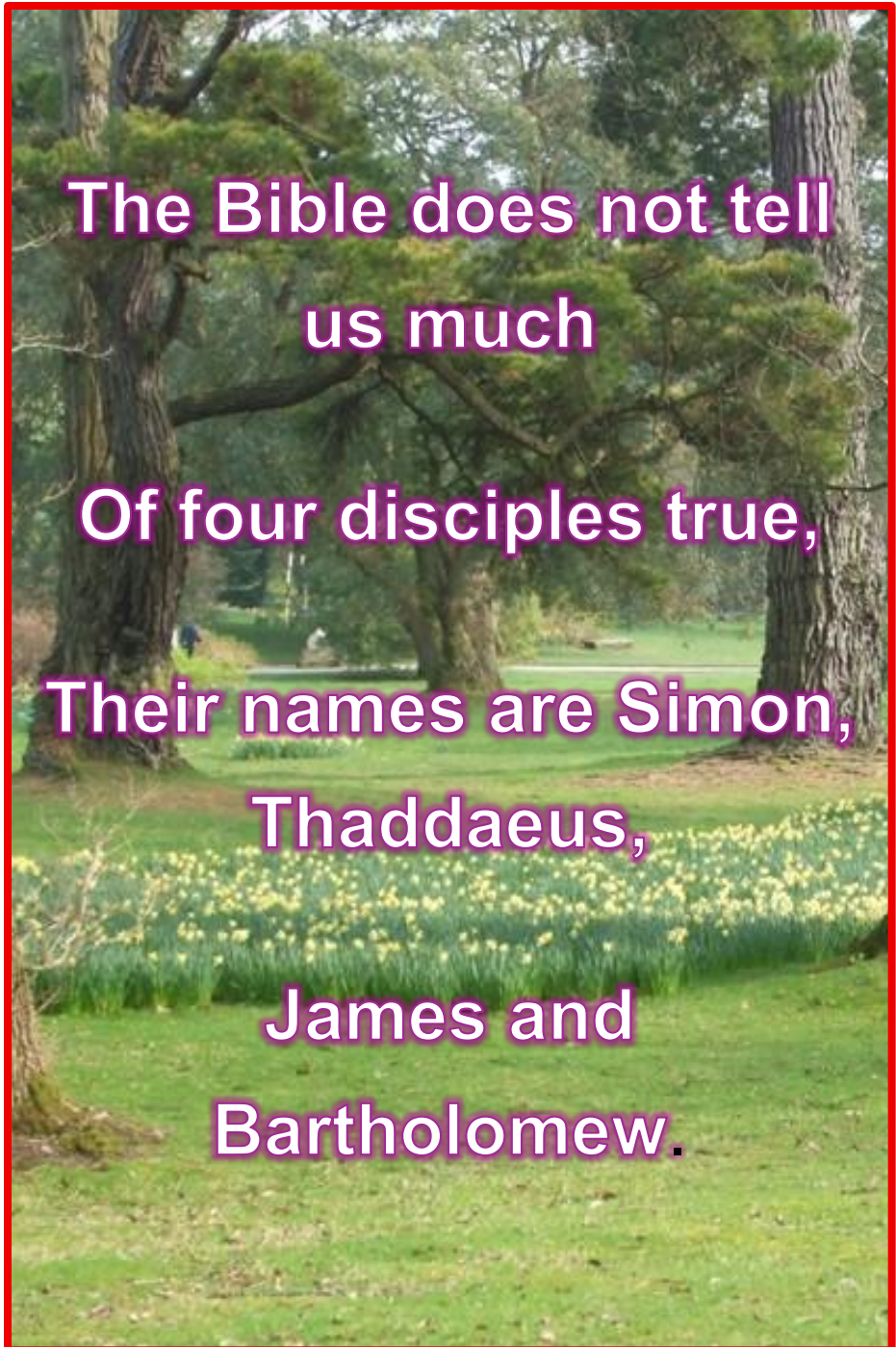

us much

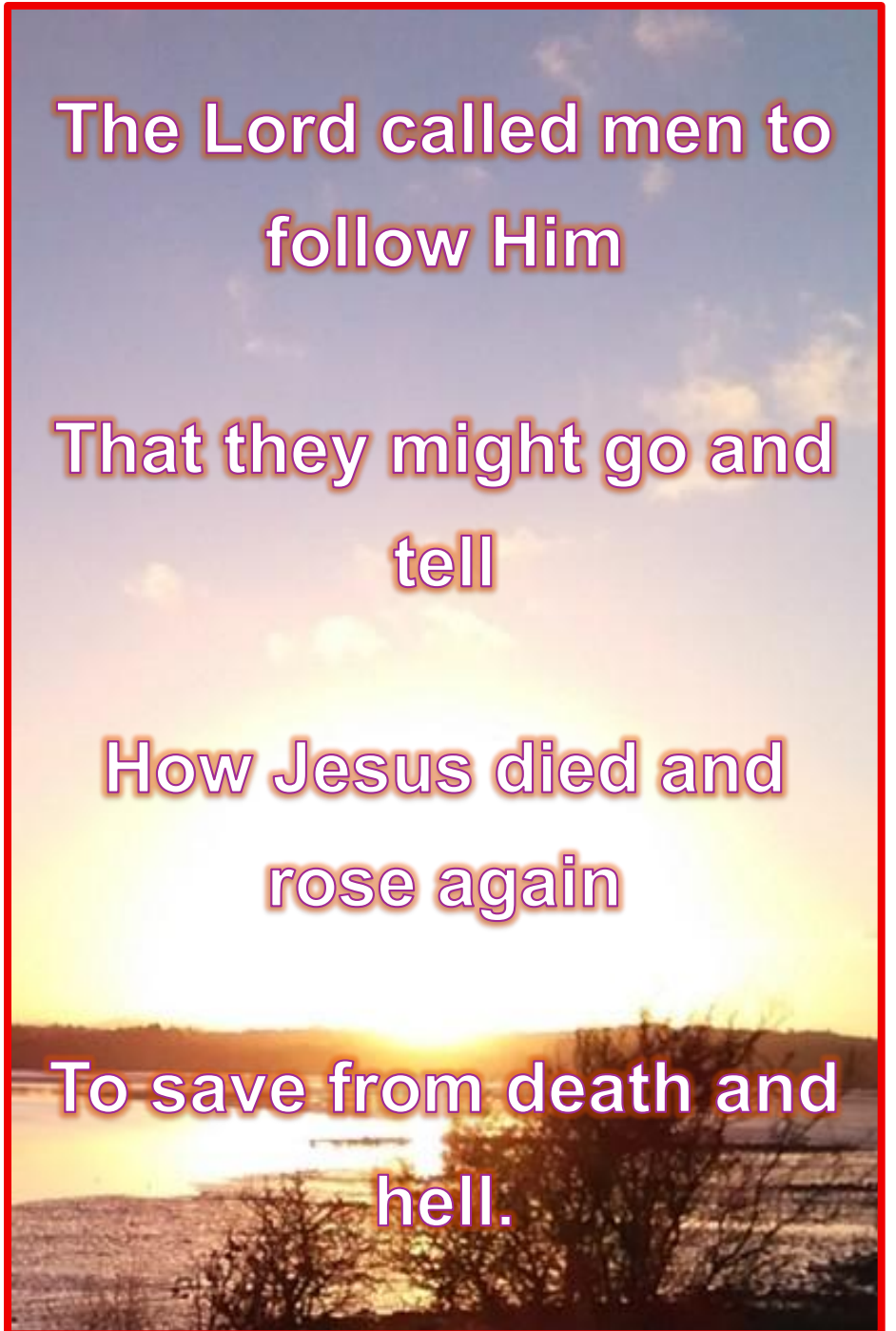
Of four disciples true,

The Twelve Disciples

Matthew chapter 10 verses 2 – 4

2. Now the names of the twelve apostles are these: first Simon, who is called Peter, and Andrew his brother; James the son of Zebedee, and John his brother.
3. Philip and Bartholomew, Thomas and Matthew the tax collector; James the son of Alphaeus, and Lebbaeus, whose surname was Thaddaeus;
4. Simon the Cananite, and Judas Iscariot, who also betrayed Him.

Luke chapter 6 verses 13 – 16

13. And when it was day, He called His disciples to Himself; and from them He chose twelve whom He also named apostles:
14. Simon, who He also named Peter, and Andrew his brother; James and John; Philip and Bartholomew;
15. Matthew and Thomas; James the son of Alphaeus, and Simon called the Zealot;
16. Judas the son of James, and Judas Iscariot who also became a traitor.
